## Introducing the CalFresh Restaurant Meals Program!

The County of Santa Cruz Restaurant Meals Program enables eligible CalFresh\* recipients to purchase a nutritious prepared meal at participating restaurants with their Electronic Benefits Transfer (EBT) card.

### Who Can Use the Program?

The Restaurant Meals Program is available to persons that receive CalFresh who:

- Are experiencing homelessness;
- Are age 60 or over; or
- Have a disability.

Restaurant Meals Program participants can continue to use their CalFresh benefits at grocery stores, farmer's markets, and other locations that accept EBT cards.

### Where Can You Use the Program?

Participating restaurants will have an "EBT Cards Accepted Here" sign displayed.
